Here's a brief guide on what to wear during different sessions and off-campus trips we may have throughout the week. # **Off-Campus Trips / Service Project**

Arlington National Cemetery: red polo & black pants/ knee-length skirt / bermuda shorts with comfortable walking shoes (walking & hot). If you are chosen to lay the wreath at Arlington, you must have black pants or a skirt and wear closed-toe black flat dress shoes.

Monument Tour: red polo & black pants/ knee-length skirt/ bermuda shorts with comfortable walking shoes (lots of walking & hot)

*Twilight Tattoo: r*ed polo & black pants / knee-length skirt / bermuda shorts with comfortable walking shoes

*Capitol Hill:* red polo & black pants/ knee-length skirt with comfortable, black, flat shoes (lots of walking & hot)

Service Project: red polo & black pants/ knee-length skirt/ bermuda shorts

casual and comfortable clothes

#### **Government Sessions**

Red polo & black pants/ knee-length skirt or business attire

*President/Vice President Candidates:* business attire

#### Last day

*Commencement*: cocktail dress or dressy top & pants

After Party: causal clothes, shorts

### Final notes on dress code:

\*You will receive 2 red polos when checking in. Laundry will be done throughout the week.

- \*Upon arrival, you will change into your red polo & black pants/ knee-length skirt
- \*If visiting the White House: red polo & black pants/ knee-length skirt

\*Tennis shoes are fine, except for Capitol Hill Day and White House Visit (pending)

\*If you are wearing something that is not an appropriate length for shorts or business attire, we will ask you to change.
