

ALA Girls Nation Government Overview

Saturday Evening:	Senators are sworn in as citizens of ALA Girls Nation
Sunday Afternoon:	ALA Girls Nation is organized into 8 communities. Each community will consist of Senators in either the Federalist or Nationalist Party. Each community elects 2 Party Delegates. Eight Senators for each party are eligible to run for Party Chairman, Party Vice-chairman, Party Secretary. The other five delegates are appointed as committee chairmen.
Sunday Evening:	Election of ALA Girls Nation Senate Pro Tem, Secretary, Chaplain, Sergeant-at-Arms, and Reporter. The Secretary and Sgt.-at-Arms each appoint an assistant. Committee hearings for all bills (chairman and secretary)
Monday Morning:	Political party meetings Election of party floor leaders and whips Selection of keynote speakers
Monday Evening:	Senate committee reports Debate
Tuesday:	Party conventions Selection of candidates for President and Vice-president Debate
Wednesday:	Party Rallies, Whistle Stops, Election, Election Results
Thursday:	Capitol Hill Day, Inauguration
Friday:	Presidential press conference, debate, veto, override, sine die, ceremonial signing of bills
